Jennifer acquired her first motorcycle when she was 18 and began her motorcycle mechanic apprenticeship when she was 20, while still living in Germany. She moved to San Francisco in 1993 and worked at a shop for eight months before deciding that she could do a better job on her own. Wrenching on bikes in a small space out of the back of a welding shop, Jennifer eventually found the warehouse for Werkstatt in the Mission

District. In 1995 she moved in, working in the back by herself for two years before hiring employees. For six years Jennifer lived in an apartment above the shop, but this became a problem as some customers considered her to be "on call" even during off-hours. At Werkstatt her duties now range from mechanic to technical advisor to shop foreman to boss, and she also spends time up front dealing with customers. A former Sidecar and AFM racer, Jennifer can also be found in the pits at the track as a sponsor and mechanic for various riders. In 2006 Jennifer was the crew chief for a rider in the AMA Nationals at Laguna Seca in Monterey, which was happening at the same time as the world-famous Moto GP.
